

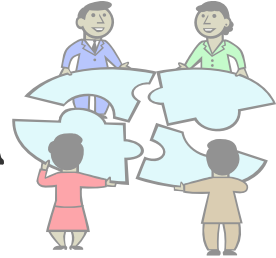

Our **Spanish Language Program** is a unique way to learn Spanish while exploring such themes as Bolivian history and current social issues and events.

Our program offers

- Classes for all levels
- Flexible scheduling
- One-on-one instruction (or in a group by request)
- Convenient location
- Professionally trained professors
- Innovative teaching methodology

There is no standard teaching text as each lesson is individually design for the student. Our participatory methodology includes options for local field trips and full access to our multimedia library. Additionally, we periodically offer cultural events and tours to historical and cultural sites around Cochabamba and beyond to complement your language study.

IMMERSION LANGUAGE PROGRAM

This program is the most intensive language study program we offer and is recommended for beginning students who want a strong foundation or for more advanced students working to perfect their language skills. The basic course is one month long and covers all verb tenses and basic grammatical constructions.

In order to provide the most effective teaching methodology you work with a team of two teachers who collaboratively design your daily lessons. The immersion program consists of two hour and a half sessions daily. All of our professors have more than 15 years of teaching experience and are well trained in teaching Spanish as a second language

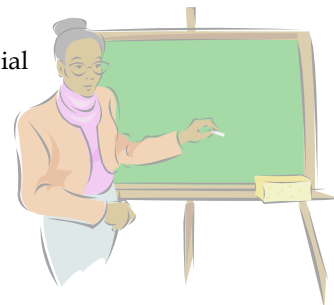


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The **objectives** of our immersion program are:

- Teach students to speak and understand Spanish within a political, social and cultural context.
- Immerse students in Bolivian culture.
- Encourage students to participate in the wide variety of cultural and social activities in the community.
- Broaden the student's understanding of the political complexities of Bolivia.



WEEKLY CLASSES

For travelers, long-termers, or those who want to keep studying Spanish after they finish the immersion course, we offer the option of studying by the week. These sessions can be arranged according to your schedule and needs. We also offer classes that focus on advanced grammar, writing and reading.

We also offer classes in **Quechua**, one of Bolivia's main indigenous languages. Quechua is widely spoken in and around Cochabamba and throughout the Andes as it was the main language of the Inca Empire.

HOMESTAYS

To compliment your language learning, we offer the option of **living with a family** during your time in Bolivia. We work with specially selected families in the city of Cochabamba. Our homestay program is an incomparable chance to practice your newly learned Spanish while experiencing Bolivian family life, making friends and participate in daily life. Your accommodations include your own room and three meals a day.

So whether you are a beginner traveling Latin America for the first time or an advanced speaker looking to brush up on your subjunctive, **Volunteer Bolivia's Spanish Program** is for you.
